## delegate information sheet

The main campus area at Keele is the thriving heart of the University and provides extensive meeting space out of term time. Venues include the Chancellor's Building, housing the 400-capacity Westminster lecture theatre, the Exhibition Hall, the Leisure Centre and over twenty syndicate rooms.

Additional lecture theatres cater for seminars, smaller groups and break-out sessions. Keele's contemporary Medical School adds striking modern design and more large-scale lecture theatre space.

Campus accommodation is available during vacation times and includes over 2,000 bedrooms just a short walk from the conference area. Bars, shops and gardens are close by and the University's Leisure Centre is available to overnight guests.

### Bedrooms

The event you are attending will be taking place on the main University campus and you will be staying in one of our Halls of Residences, which are all located a short walking distance from our restaurants and meeting rooms (please see our campus map or contact your event organiser for more details). It may be advisable that you bring an umbrella and comfortable footwear.



Your bedroom will be a single room with en-suite or standard facilities. All bedrooms are equipped with tea and coffee making facilities, towels and toiletries and a telephone (see below for more information). Irons and ironing boards are available throughout our halls and notices will indicate where these are located.

We would advise that you bring your own hairdryer and alarm clock, as these are not supplied in the bedrooms.

Please confirm with your Event Organiser the type of room that you will occupy. All bedrooms are non-smoking

### Telephones

All rooms are equipped with a free room-to-room/direct-dial telephone, operated by a "key com" system. In order to use your room phone externally you are requested to register, via your room phone, by providing your credit/debit card details. Further information is available from reception.

### Reception

Our staff will be pleased to answer your queries between 8.30am – 7pm at Chancellors or Darwin Receptions. You can contact both receptions by internal phone



from your hall of residence. Outside of these hours please contact our 24hr security team who will be pleased to help.

### Luggage

A luggage store will be available on arrival. Please speak to a member of staff at your key registration for more details

### Check in and check out times

Rooms will be available after 1pm for check in. Please vacate your bedroom by 9.30am on your day of departure. On departure keys are to be deposited in the "key return boxes", located in the halls of residence. Please inform your event organiser prior to arrival, of any difficulties you may have in the unlikely event of an evacuation (e.g. hearing or walking difficulties).

## Internet access

Wi-fi internet access is available within the Chancellor's Building. Please speak to a member of staff at Chancellor's Reception for more information and to obtain your log-in details.

## Meals

Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be provided in one of our 3 restaurants. All our restaurants offer excellent buffet style lunch, a cooked or continental breakfast and evening meals. Your event organiser will be able to advise you regarding the catering arrangements for your event. Our café bar is located in Chancellor's building, ideal for networking or a quiet drink during your day and serves tea, coffee and a variety of wines, beers, spirits and soft drinks.

## Launderettes

Coin operated launderettes are available on campus at the following halls – Horwood, Barnes, Lindsays and Hawthorns. Please contact reception to obtain an access card (£10 deposit payable).

## Sports and leisure facilities

All residential guests have use of the campus grounds and complimentary use of the fitness centre. Other facilities, including squash and tennis courts are available. To make use of the facilities please take your bedroom key and present it at the Leisure Centre Reception.

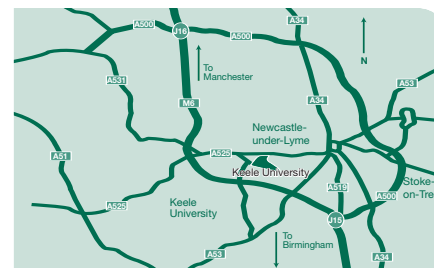

## Car parking

Free parking is available across campus with disabled parking available close to all building entrances. Limited parking is available at the Halls of Residence, your event organiser will provide more information regarding your car parking arrangements. Parking permits will be issued before or during registration. These must be completed and displayed for the duration of your stay on the University campus. Please note that a fine may be levied for any unauthorised parking.

## Getting here - road, rail, air

Keele University is easy to get to. The campus is located on the outskirts of the market town of Newcastle Under Lyme, 15 minutes from Junction 15 & 16 of the M6, and easily accessed from M6 toll road, M1, A34 and A50.



### Road

The University is easily accessed from the Midlands network of motorways. A map can be obtained from your event organiser, or you can download our visitor map as a PDF from our website – [www.keele-conference.com](http://www.keele-conference.com) and click on delegate information.

### Public transport

Buses from Stoke-on-Trent Station: First Buses operate a number of services.

Buses from Crewe Station: D&G buses to Newcastle (No. 85A service) leave from the stop to the right of the station entrance towards the roundabout. The Sunday service is the two hourly Baker Bus Service 85A.

Manchester International Airport is approximately 50 minutes away.

Birmingham International Airport is approximately 1 hour away.

### Rail

Stoke-on-Trent station is 5 miles from the University and Crewe station is approximately 12 miles.

Services from Euston to Stoke-on-Trent run approximately every 30 minutes. The journey time is approximately 2 hours.

Services from Euston to Crewe run approximately every 20 minutes. The journey time is approximately 2 hours.

Services from Birmingham to Stoke-on-Trent run approximately every 30 minutes. The journey time is approximately 1 hour.

Services from Manchester to Stoke-on-Trent run approximately every 15 minutes. The journey time is approximately 45 minutes.
